The new 2015 UNICEF "Rights of the Child" goals

have been a focus for all pupils this term. We began with visits from teachers of our partner schools in Botswana and Tanzania and spent a week studying "The Worlds Largest Lesson"

We responded to the refugee crisis by collecting clothing, tents etc which were delivered by Anthea Guthrie to a refugee camp in Dunkirk in France. Harvest celebrations included an Apple Day, Go Green Day, Dizzy Goals and a collection of food for the Bridgend Food bank. Developing curriculum work through projects like this is the heart of the new Donaldson review for Welsh Education and we are proud to coordinate a network of schools working on Global issues and awareness. Senior pupils enjoyed a day at Ewenny Priory. They dressed as monks and learned about stained glass windows, pottery and herbal medicines.

Leavers The Leavers' Department expanded the range of vocational options at Heronsbridge

this year to include a Sport & Fitness Studies course. Mr Price's connections in the sporting world have already paid dividends with a visit from Thinus Delport, a former South African rugby player, as part of the Sky Sports 'Living for Sport' project. Thinus spent a morning at school speaking to students about the Sky Sports 'Six Keys to Success', including raising self-esteem, developing self-confidence and encouraging young people to break through barriers through participation in

sport. This is an ongoing partnership for the school with more exciting visits to come. The whole Department also attended a "What's next?" Careers event.

Centre for Autism

A big welcome back to all staff and pupils this autumn term! We welcome many new pupils (too many to name here!) and three new teachers to the department this term! Its been a busy first half term and we have certainly hit the ground running and dived straight into our new topic which is Ourselves. There have been new sessions in the DYB Resource base of Resonance Boards which many of the pupils department have quickly accepted and thoroughly enjoyed.

Two classes, A8 and A9, are now located close to the Leavers and Senior departments. This enables staff to share expertise and resources between the Centre for Autism and the main body of the school and allows pupils to access lessons within other classes if appropriate.
