Dear Parent/Carer,

Following another difficult year of Covid disruptions I am writing to thank you all for your support this year and to let you know the arrangements for our September return.

- On Thursday September 2nd, **all Bridgend schools are closed**, to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.
- On Friday September 3rd, we will be open for **staff INSET** only **no pupils**.
- On Monday September 6th, **all pupils** will return to Heronsbridge, at the usual school times of 08.50am to 15.15pm.

In line with Welsh Government easing of restrictions – Alert Level One, July 17th and Alert Level Zero, August 7th – there will be some changes in the operation of schools, as head teachers work out what a "return to as near normality as possible" means!

Bridgend County Borough Council has set out new September 2021 operational processes for schools, where some measures remain in place and some measures have changed. Key points include:

- Staff social distancing (where possible), enhanced cleaning, enhanced ventilation & signage and enhanced hand hygiene measures will remain.
- Higher levels of outdoor learning will continue to be promoted.
- 'Class bubbles' can expand to multiple classes or 'department bubbles'.
- Large gatherings are limited to bubble sizes for the time being, there will be no
 physical whole-school assemblies and parent meetings & annual review meetings
 will continue to be held virtually, via Teams or the telephone.
- Staff will continue to wear enhanced PPE for personal care and intimate care giving
 and we will encourage the wearing of a face covering when travelling around the
 building. Staff & older pupils can continue to wear face coverings if they so wish.
- School visitors must wear a face covering and limit their time on site.
